A reliable outpatient referral pathway after discharge, crisis stabilization, or emergency care.



Designed for emergency departments, inpatient units, crisis teams, discharge planners, social workers, and care coordinators.

Alliance BHI assists hospitals, emergency departments, crisis stabilization units, and discharge planning teams by providing a referral pathway for individuals who need outpatient behavioral health or addiction recovery follow-up after discharge. Services may include post-discharge behavioral health follow-up, medication management requests, therapy connection, relapse prevention planning, crisis prevention planning, MAT review when appropriate, and care coordination.

Our goal is to support smoother transitions from acute care to outpatient services and reduce gaps that can contribute to relapse, repeat crisis episodes, or loss of engagement.

When to Refer

- ✓ Needs outpatient follow-up after hospitalization or ER care
- ✓ Is stepping down from detox, rehab, residential, or IOP care
- ✓ Needs help staying engaged in behavioral health treatment
- ✓ Has relapse concerns or substance use triggers
- ✓ Needs addiction treatment support or MAT review
- ✓ Needs DUI screening or DUI education
- ✓ Has court, probation, DMV, or compliance-related requirements
- ✓ Needs safety planning or crisis prevention support
- ✓ Needs therapy, medication management, or care coordination
- ✓ Would benefit from structured outpatient accountability

Services May Include

Behavioral Health Evaluation & Treatment Planning

Clinical review and treatment planning to identify current needs, symptoms, risks, strengths, and appropriate next steps.

MAT Treatment Support

Medication-Assisted Treatment may be offered when clinically appropriate to help reduce cravings, improve stability, and support recovery with counseling and behavioral health care.

Medication Management Coordination

Psychiatric evaluation or medication management support may be coordinated to help improve stability and treatment consistency.

Care Coordination

With authorization, coordination may include hospitals, courts, probation, behavioral health providers, primary care, rehab programs, family, caregivers, and community partners.

Addiction Recovery Support

Support for alcohol, opiate, methamphetamine, and other substance use concerns through recovery planning, relapse prevention, counseling connection, and structured follow-up.

Therapy & Counseling Connection

Connection to individual therapy, group therapy, trauma therapy, grief support, addiction counseling, or other therapeutic services based on need and availability.

Crisis Prevention & Safety Planning

Support with early warning signs, triggers, coping strategies, safety planning, and strengthening support systems.

Documentation & Compliance Support

When appropriate and authorized, documentation may include referral status, appointment attendance, participation updates, care coordination notes, DUI-related documentation, and compliance reporting.
